Heritage Significance

The one-and-a-half-storey Robert Polk house is brick, plastered on the first-floor front and side walls, with brick quoining and a brick wing extending to the rear. A clapboard woodshed and summer kitchen are attached to the rear extension. A verandah with decorative trellis work covers the first-floor front and sides of the house.

The solid five-paneled door is centrally located along the façade and is set in a recess with moulded frame, rectangular transom with multiple lights and sidelights.

The patterned metal roof contains a gable in the façade with a rectangular casement window and semi-elliptical head, and two dormer windows, gabled with projecting eaves in the rear wing roof.
