**PURPOSE:** This is an application under Section 45 of the Ontario Planning Act requesting minor variances from the provisions of the Township of Rideau Lakes’ Zoning By-law #2005-6 as amended. The applicant is proposing to construct a 10.2sqm (110sqft) 1-storey rear addition to the existing 44.6sqm (480sqft) 1 storey dwelling. The existing dwelling is located 2.4m (8ft) from the southern interior side lot line and the proposed addition is to maintain this setback. Additionally the existing dwelling is located 13m (42.5ft) from the centreline of Lake Shore Drive and the addition is to be located further from the centreline. The following variances are requested:

- **Section 3.23** – Relief of 1m from the required minimum 20m centreline of Township street setback to allow for a 19m centreline of Township street setback for the proposed dwelling addition.
- **Section 11.1.2** – Relief of 3.6m from the required minimum 6m interior side yard setback to allow for a 2.4m southern interior side yard setback for the proposed dwelling addition.
