**PURPOSE:** This is an application under Section 45 of the Ontario Planning Act requesting a permission to expand a non-conforming use. The structure is currently non-conforming due to the existing distance of 5.48m to the high water mark whereas 30m is required. The applicants are proposing two additions totaling 370sqft on to an existing 1745sqft 1-storey dwelling (including attached garage): a 330sqft 1-storey addition and a 40sqft 1-storey addition. The additions are to go farther from the water than the existing structure. The property also contains a 245sqft 1-storey sleeping cabin and 255sqft of decking attached to the existing dwelling. The decking is proposed to be demolished.
